Minutes of September 5th meeting were approved.

Financial reports were distributed and reviewed.

<u>Hope Cemetery.</u> We reviewed James (Woody) Woodman's work restoring stones. He has fixed 10 stones and will return to do more when his schedule allows. Matt has begun to clean stones in Section D – from the beginning down to and including Dr. Janes. He will finish this month.

Potter will trim oak trees along Old Stagecoach Inn property and will furnish cherry picker when Matt cleans C.C. Warren obelisk.

Highway Department will continue to clear brush; sumac and Japanese knotweed. They have weed wacked front entrance area which is a big improvement.

There have been 12 grave openings so far this year.

<u>Maple Street Cemetery.</u> There was discussion about the condition of the roads in the cemetery. Reclaimed asphalt was supposed to be spread on the roads but that has not happened. Bill Woodruff will look into what happened.

John has purchased 10 flag holders for replacement of those damaged by mowing. There have been complaints by family of lot owners about damage.

All agreed to cut down the dying cedar tree behind bulletin board. Perhaps a tree from the grant can be planted as a replacement. Tree Committee has staked out placement for oak trees along the entrance driveway. Izor overgrowth?

There have been 20 grave openings so far this year.

Loomis Hill Cemetery. Wording for George St. Clair stone was finalized.

Meeting adjourned at 5:00 PM – Next meeting will be November 7th.
