- **Demeritt Cemetery.** We adjourned to the cemetery to see what condition it is in. The stones are in remarkably good shape considering the lack of maintenance over the years. John will ask to have the brush cleared before winter. We counted 13 stones. It is surrounded by a stone wall. The neighbor asked about taking down a large tree on his property.
