- <u>Maple Street Cemetery</u> Jack said that the shed transformation project has been completed and looks nice. One thing that needs to be done is move the water spigot. John has been in contact with the Water Department. He has also asked Celia about road work and that might get done this year. The cost of a new flag pole will be split four ways – VFW fund, SAL, Legion and the Cemetery Commission. The cost will be \$1,600 total and will be aluminum and the same as the one in Holy Cross Cemetery. David Dow is involved with the project.
- <u>Hope Cemetery</u> John Farr has been contacted about the removing the cedar hedge. He has given the information to his son. Bill Shepeluk would like an estimate for the cost. Matt Fitzgerald has cleaned 35 stones along section A. Jan and Jack have planted perennials in the lower fountain base.
- Other business; Barbara MacGregor has been informed that Woody might be able to repair stones in the cemeteries at Little River State Park in the spring. There have been 32 burial and inurnments this year. The genealogical group has not decided yet about updating the 2000 book.
