- 1. Call meeting to order. @4:35PM
- 2. Change/adoption of agenda.

Alice approved the agenda; Shannon seconded.

3. Approve July, 2018 minutes.

Alice approved the minutes; Shannon seconded.

4. Town Manager's Report

Initially skipped because Town Manager not present.

- 5. Treasurer's Report
 - 1. Almy gave Alice copy of last month's report given to her by Bill that morning
 - 2. Library trust fund value increased in the last month
 - a. Explanation of trust fund usage and contributions to town
 - 3. Last year we agreed to allow trust funds for long term large library expenditures (durable goods)
 - 4. Almy asked the process and we decided that Director would have to present proposal to commission and it would have to be voted.
 - 5. Town was paid \$35,000 in May
 - 6. Alice provided an explanation of how the trust fund money is divided; every year we give the town x amount of dollars.
 - 7. Dan now has signing authority on VSECU account but Alice is still the only person on the Morgan Stanley account.
 - 8. Discussion of trust/updating the trust account
 - 9. Almy asked about SAL room fees and policy of those being paid to the town. Why not Fund 14?
- 6. Library Director's Report
 - 1. Almy asked for brief summary of the budget process.
 - 2. Dan raised the idea of creating a schedule for commissioners. (With dates including when we start the budget process, etc.)
 - a. Dan thought November for draft, December for final, January to present to select board, and March to be voted on at town meeting
 - 3. Almy asked about trustee resources.
 - a. Dan provided us with binder of trustee handbook and bylaws
 - i. Would like to add policies at some point. (I.e. Privacy)
 - 1. Also great idea to add policies to the website
 - ii. Explanation of privacy policy followed
 - iii. Asked Almy for meeting room policy
 - iv. Digital space for commissioners that's secure? (Not Google)
 - v. Bob created a partition of the server of Mary's files. Almy also has her own partition.
 - vi. What does Select Board use for their docs?
 - 4. Bill stepped in for a brief Town Manager report.
 - a. Almy and Bill reviewed the budget. Few line items are over but nothing to worry about.
 - b. 67% of year-budget 41% (spent or left?); some transfers have not gone through yet.
 - c. Town website is not updated with current commissioners or meeting notes.
 - d. Bill agreed to meet with Almy in October to discuss budget a bit earlier than usual.

6. Resumed Library Director report

- 1) Trouble covering vacations-substitute pool? There is a sub line in the budget.
 - a) Sub pay is \$10.50. Discussed comparable libraries and comparison pay.
- 2) Dan asked about Almy meeting 1-1 with staff. Scheduled meetings for most employees this week and next. One waiting to be scheduled.

7. Other Business:

- 1. Alice discussed great ideas people suggested at interviews. First Wednesdays through VT Humanities Council
 - a. Almy believes the VT Humanities Council chooses the sites.
- 2. Christine wondered about programming statistics. What affects programming?
- 3. Discussion of different unique programming ideas
- 4. How to target populations not engaging with the library? (I.E. teens)
- 5. Discussion of nontraditional collections (i.e. Snowshoes)
- 6. Discussion/suggestion of Teen Advisory Board
- 7. Staff wants more of a connection with Commissioners.
 - a. Suggestion of rotating staff at Commissioners Meeting
- 8. Went into executive session.
 - a. Alice moved; Christine seconded.
- 9. Christine made a motion to come out of executive session. Shannon seconded.
