Kristin will send final excel map later today after she finalizes all the spaces.

Usage Study:

How? Who? When? Where? What info to gather?

Where: Start in the "core" – Main St (from Church to 51 S. Main and municipal lot), Stowe St to dry bridge, Bidwell Lane and lots off Bidwell including SSE, Fisher Auto, etc, up to Foundry, including TDBank lot, Steele Block lot, and all of Elm Street including municipal lot behind Pro Pig. If we only count the core the issue, concern is that we will identify that employees "should" park in the fringe and should we know where, exactly, that will be? We can people go? It needs to be public parking.

How: Natalie shared the sample grid by the half hour. Four half hour loops around the whole village. Don will test this before the next meeting. Do we do it manually or on a laptop? Using check marks or code it out? We need to be consistent and to develop a system. Fauna and Hiata will also do a half hour loop to test.
