- 1. Agenda review: The agenda was reviewed and no changes were made.
- **2. Public comment & announcements:** There were no members of the public present and no announcements were made.
- 3. Review and approve minutes for last meeting held on May 22, 2019: The minutes were reviewed and approved as drafted. They including a walk along Winooski St. to identify potential tree planting sites.

- **5. Emerald Ash Borer Management Plan:** We are ready to get started on the EAB Management Plan with Redstart, a forestry/wildlife management firm from Bradford/Corinth VT. They completed the Randolph EAB Management Plan. A kick-off meeting will be held in December.
- **6. The Annual Tree Committee Report:** We can use the 2018 Report as a model for our 2019 Report . Jack Carter agreed to write up the annual report.
- 7. The Caring for Canopy grant: The grant program from the Vt. Dept of Forests

 Parks and Recreation will take applications in January. Jane Brown offered to help

 Steve Lotspeich on the grant. Steve will bring some paper copies of the grant
 program materials to our next meeting.

- **8. Master Plan for the Maple St. Cemetery:** A master plan is needed for the landscaping for the cemetery. We should complete that to guide us on future tree planting.
- **9. Branch Out Burlington 2020 sale:** This sale is for bare root trees. We should consider ordering a few low-cost trees since they are cheaper and easy to handle once picked up. We should also continue with Evergreen Gardens as they have done a good job on tree planting since the town crew is generally too busy.

10. Tree Planting Budget: Steve is putting together a budget for 2020 and we are requesting a greater amount than previous years to include tree planting at a few key locations. The Caring for Canopy grant funds and match will be included in this budget request.
