AGENDA REVIEW AND MODIFICATIONS

No changes were requested.

ANNOUNCEMENTS AND COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC There were none.

DISCUSS MUNICIPAL PLAN UPDATE INCLUDING THE DRAFT ENERGY PLAN AND ENERGY CHAPTER

- 1. The introduction for each of the chapters needs to be written indicating the updates or give a synopsis of the changes by chapter in the Introduction.
 - a. Steve will do this starting on Tuesday.
 - b. It was suggested to make a list or a table that identifies "focused updates".
- 2. The maps don't take in to account the zoning rewrite in the downtown area.
- 3. The land use update deals primarily with the forest fragmentation and connectivity update and mapping.
- 4. Include footnote/s on the map (addressing Eric's concern).
- 5. Consider having one natural resources map that includes everything and can be updated as changes are made. Steve explained that the current Natural Features and Wildlife Resources maps are referenced in the Zoning Regulations so don't want to confuse that regulatory reference.
- 6. LOCAL ECONOMY needs some figures/tables that didn't transfer in from the file transfer.
- 7. On page 31 the use of lower case vs. upper case was discussed for the goals, objectives, and actions. Capitalize the first letter or each heading word.
- 8. Page 30 confirmed there was an endorsement date
- 9. HOUSING a rewrite was done in 2013 and not updated in this version
 - a. Identify/qualify sources of information/data.
 - b. Housing costs Martha wants this to be addressed or called out and updated.
- 10. NATURAL RESOURCES
 - a. Steve made the updates that were brought forward at the June 25th meeting.
 - b. The forest resources and wildlife connectivity map was updated and reviewed with Clare
 - c. Wildlife corridors were addressed.
- 11. ENERGY CHAPTER starting on page 69 is a total rewrite.

- a. This chapter needs some formatting changes to be consistent with the rest of the document.
- 12. TRANSPORTATION no changes since a rewrite was done in 2013.
- 13. FACILITIES AND SERVICES
 - a. Needs some formatting updates and pagination.
- 14. PUBLIC SAFETY
 - a. Rewrite done.
- 15. RECREATION
 - a. Added some information on trails (added section 11 and 12)
 - b. Actions added see tracked changes version.
- 16. LOCAL GOVERNMENT (rewrite by Bill Shepeluk)
 - a. Edit paragraph on page 123 (as noted by Steve)
 - b. Page 132 why is there a question mark does it reference the table?

Steve will continue to make these recommended changes and suggested a motion to warn this draft in the Waterbury Record for the public hearing.

Notice needs to go out regarding the August 13th public hearing to the adjacent towns of Worcester, Bolton, Middlesex, Worcester, Duxbury, and Stowe, CVRPC, and the state Dept. of Housing and Community Development, at least 30 days before the hearing. That notice and the complete Draft #1 of the Plan will go out on Friday, July 13th.
