The Adult Program is designed to lead new players quickly from entry level to modified match play. The games-based method of teaching and learning is also used in this program. Players are introduced to new skills, which are reinforced through repetitive practice and supervised play.

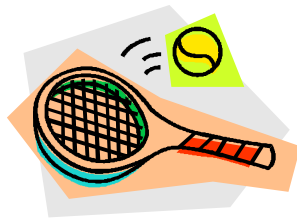

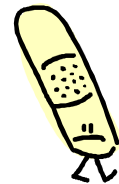
