Job Summary:

Waterbury Recreation is looking for Camp Directors to co-lead our 2025 Summer Day Camp for the Town of Waterbury. The Camp Directors will work with Recreation staff, and other camp staff and directors, as well as with campers directly, to provide a safe, responsible, wellsupervised camp. The positions are responsible for implementing activity planning and projects, fostering a positive learning environment, establishing a positive rapport with campers, guardians, and other staff, and preparing materials and supplies. Directors will communicate with guardians, coordinate with instructors, facilitate staff meetings and staff training, and generally oversee the weekly camp schedules. Ahead of summer hours, Camp Directors will be required to have 1-3 planning sessions with the Recreation Director and Program Coordinator to prepare for camp, and assist with staff training.

Duties/Responsibilities:

The Camp Directors will:

- Oversee the high-level operations of Summer Camp
- Evaluate the camp daily to suggest improvements, needs, hazards, and/or trends
- Handle communications with guardians in a timely manner
- Manage and supervise counselors
- Develop and adjust programming to meet camp needs
- Assist with the training of program staff
- Administrative work pertaining to programs
- Maintain supplies, equipment, and materials for camp operations
- Drive campers in town vehicles

The Camp Directors will need to have:

- Good customer service skills
- The ability to supervise seasonal staff
- Strong organization and problem-solving skills
- The ability to work independently and with others
- The ability to serve, communicate with, and work with a diverse population

- Must pass criminal background check
